Checkin and welcome
6:30 pm – Dinner with regional delicacies
7:30 pm - Night Safari (High probability of jaguar sighting)

07:00 Breakfast
08:00 Welcome from farm owner Roberto Coelho and overview of how they farm in a ecologically important region (ABPO).
08:45 Board the safari cars
09:00 Visit irrigated rice fields
09:45 Visit water harvesting station at the Miranda River and Carandá Trail
10:15 Visit breeding cattle in a wetland pasture (formed in the Pantanal)
10:45 Visit the Nelore and Senepol calving cowshed
11:15 Visit to the cattle confinement area
11:45 Visit fields where pasture (for grazing cattle) and annual crops are grown together
12:15 Lunch
2pm - Day Safari – (Chalana Safari) to see birds, mammals, reptiles
